Islamabad, the 1st February, 1996.

The following Acts of Majlis-e-Shoora (Parliament) received the assent of the President on the 25th January, 1996 and are hereby published for general information :

ACT NO.II of 1996.

An Act further to amend the Pakistan Standards Institution (Certification Marks) Ordinance, 1961.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Pakistan Standards Institution (Certification Marks) Ordinance, 1961 (XLVIII of 1961), for the purposes hereinafter appearing:

It is hereby enacted as follows :-

1. **Short title and commencement.- (1)** This Act may be called the Pakistan Standards Institution (Certification Marks) (Amendment) Act, 1996.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Amendment of section 2, Ordinance XLVIII of 1961.** – In the Pakistan Standards Institution (Certification Marks) Ordinance, 1961 (XLVIII of 1961), hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 2, after clause (g), the following new clause shall be inserted, namely :-

“(gg) “marking fee” means the fee for the use of a Standard Mark for a product;”.
3. **Amendment of section 3, Ordinance XLVIII of 1961.** – In the said ordinance, in section 3, in sub-clause (d), for the word “such” the words “marking fee or other” shall be substituted.
4. **Amendment of section 21, Ordinance XLVIII of 1961.** – In the said Ordinance, in section 21, in sub-section (2), in clause (e), after the words “Levy of”, the words “marking fee and” shall be inserted.
5. **Addition of new section 23, Ordinance XLVIII of 1961.** – In the said Ordinance, after section 22, the following new section shall be added, namely :-

“23. Validation. – Notwithstanding any order, decision or judgment of any court, any order passed or proceedings taken for levy of marking fee or its collection or any recovery of such fee made or collected under the provisions of this Ordinance or any rules or regulations made there under at any time before the commencement of the Pakistan Standards Institution (Certification Marks) (Amendment) Act, 1996 (II of 1996), purporting to be in exercise of the authority conferred on the Institution or any of its officer shall be deemed to have been validly passed, taken, levied, recovered and collected and shall have, and shall be deemed always to have had, effect accordingly.”.

**Subject : PURCHASE OF GOODS CONFORMING TO PSI STANDARDS OR
INTERNATION STANDARDS**

The undersigned is directed to say that the ECC in its meeting held on 20th August, 1973 at Islamabad, took the following decision :-

“Where standards have been prescribed by PSI, all public sector purchases, including Defence purchases, should be restricted to goods which conform to PSI Standards or International Standards”.

2. Pakistan Standards are formulated by the Pakistan Standards Institution. These Standards are established with the consensus of opinion of the representatives of the Federal and Provincial Government as well as manufacturers and _____ interests with trade and industry who constitute the various technical committee responsible for formulation of Standards, PSI has so far formulated 943 Pakistan Standards on various items of trade and industry. Complete information about these Standards is contained in the ‘PSI Year Book’ which can be obtained on payment of Rs.10/- from the Offices of PSI at Karachi and Lahore.

3. In view of the above mentioned decision of the ECC, it is requested that necessary stamps may kindly be taken to ensure that Pakistan Standards or International Standards should be prescribed in procurement of all goods by all Government, Semi-Government, Autonomous Organization/Departments under your control.
